this book offers an interesting synthesis of social movements studies and international relations ir focusing on emotions the holistic scope and the different conceptualizations of emotions in environmental movements will bring a new perspective that expands the existing approaches of social movements studies and ir although the existing literature on emotions in social movements offers rich insights the detailed analytical framework of emotions in environmental movements is overlooked in particular the realm of emotions and their intricate interaction with environmental activism remains overlooked in the context of green politics by building on significant studies in emotions in ir this book aims to transcend the boundaries of state centric discussions to create a platform for the manifestation of social movements

what is time and how does it influence our knowledge of international politics for decades international relations ir paid little explicit attention to time recently this

began to change as a range of scholars took an interest in the temporal dimensions of politics yet ir still has not fully addressed the issue of why time matters in international politics nor has it reflected on its own use of time how temporal ideas affect the way we work to understand political phenomena moreover ir remains beholden to two seemingly contradictory visions of time the time of the clock and a longstanding tradition treating time as a problem to be solved international relations and the problem of time develops a unique response to these interconnected puzzles it reconstructs ir s temporal imagination by developing an argument that all times from natural rhythms to individual temporal experience spring from social and practical timing activities or efforts to establish meaningful and useful relationships in complex and dynamic settings in ir s case across a surprisingly wide range of approaches scholars employ narrative timing techniques to make sense of confounding processes and events this innovative account of time provides a more systematic and rigorous explanation for time in international politics it also develops provocative insights about ir s own history its key methodological commitments supposedly timeless statistical methods historical institutions and the critical vanguard of time studies this book invites us to reimagine time and in so doing to significantly rethink the way we approach the analysis of international politics

globalizing international theory adds to the literature on non western international relations ir theory by probing the question of what it means to globalize international theory the book starts with the premise that international theory is unfinished incomplete and homogenous because it provides a limited conception of the international which in turn derives from its partiality that reflects its narrow western centric bias the contributors argue that the ir vision of the world is projected through a polarizing western filtered lens rather than utilizing an objective set of explanatory tools for explaining world politics the reality is that orthodox ir theory only tells us why the west is best and why the rest should become like the west this means that international theory is not truly international in provincializing western international theory this volume navigates beyond the eurocentric and imperial frontier of the prevailing limited conception of the international to explore the hidden contributions to international theory which can be found in the non western world bringing in excluded non western conceptions of international theory highlights a broader conception of the international the book provides a framework for theorizing globally exploring the fundamental problems with western ir theory and how to overcome them this book will be used by advanced undergraduate and postgraduate students scholars researchers and ir theorists worldwide who are interested in non western ir theory it will help navigate the problem of internationalness in the face of the grand theoretical problem of our time the use and misuse of international theory in making sense of and responding to the complex global realities of the twenty first century
